The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has published a notice in the *Federal Register* confirming its receipt of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the Interim Storage Partners, LLC license application for a consolidated interim storage facility (CISF) for spent nuclear fuel and Greater Than Class C radioactive waste in Andrews County, Texas. The NRC staff made the FEIS publicly available on July 29, 2021. An NRC licensing decision concerning the proposed CISF is expected by the end of September 2021. A licensing decision cannot be made until 30 days after the publication of EPA's *Federal Register* notice.
