Attendees: Ashley Waldron, Christine Pineda, Jessie Quintero, Lee Anna Martinez, Dawn Begay, Dariel Yazzie

1. Biweekly Meetings – NRC had suggested increasing time from 30 minutes to 90 minutes. NNEPA asked to extend biweekly calls to 1 hour – **ACTION: Ashley will revise scheduler to extend meetings (DONE)**
2. Pipeline Road Community meeting – NNEPA provided positive feedback from community, Navajo translator was well received, maps were small and hard to read, EPA could have provided more input on CERCLA actions, timeline regarding construction activities and more photographs (e.g. jetty and mill site) would be helpful for future meetings

Lee Anna inquired about how the comments received at the meeting would be handled and indicated the community intended to submit comments in writing. NRC is preparing a meeting summary that will be made publicly available; NRC encouraged the community to also submit written comments; **ACTION: Lee Anna will provide meeting feedback in writing and community contact information; NRC will look into transcribing the comments received at the meeting (from recording)**

3. NNEPA suggested an NRC liaison – someone who could put “boots on the ground” within the community to discuss the project and answer questions and asked about the role of the liaisons. **ACTION: NRC will ask Tribal Liaison to be on next call to explain the role of the NRC’s tribal liaison.**
4. NRC provided an update on the letter to Director Shirley – describing NRC outreach efforts during extended DEIS comment period; NRC to send out letter no later than early next week.
5. NRC provided a status update on its outreach to chapter houses about future meetings – Initial interest from Standing Rock and Pinedale – Pinedale said it would be open to a virtual meeting – Christine sent emails last week and copied NNEPA staff; **ACTION: Christine will forward those emails again to NNEPA (DONE); ACTION: Lee Anna will follow-up with chapters**
6. NNEPA suggested engaging the Navajo delegates– invite to Chapter meetings or separate meeting. Dariel suggested reaching out to speaker Damien. **ACTION: Lee Anna will reach out to delegates - starting with speaker Damien**
7. NNEPA also asked for a separate letter re: cancellation of public meeting; NRC described that information would be included in the letter to Director Shirley **ACTION: NRC to send notification via letter (DRAFT letter attached) – Lee Anna please confirm this what you are looking for re: letter/notification.**
