SUBJECT: Reorganization Closing and Name Change Notification for Curium US PET

Dear Mr. Orlikowski:

On June 24, 2021, Curium US Holdings LLC ("Curium") notified the NRC of a planned internal reorganization of its subsidiaries Curium US LLC and Curium US PET LLC, in which Curium US PET LLC would merge into Curium US LLC. Control of both subsidiaries pre and post-reorganization would remain with Curium.¹

On August 27, 2021, the parties completed the planned internal reorganization. The parties request that the above-listed licenses be amended to reflect the new name of the licensee post-reorganization as "Curium US LLC" instead of "Curium US PET LLC." This name change is documented in NRC Form 313 "Identifying New Licensee Name" (enclosed). Curium will also provide updated financial assurance instruments to reflect the name change for NRC License No. 13-35179-02 and 13-35179-03. As requested by Ms. Magdalena Gryglak, of the NRC staff, Curium confirms that the reorganizational changes, to the best of Curium's knowledge and understanding, do not constitute a transfer of control as described in NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Revision 1.
