By letter dated September 14, 2021, received via e-mail on September 23, 2021, NRC submitted a request for additional information associated with Homestake Mining Company's (HMC) license amendment request (LAR) regarding the background radon monitoring location for the Grants Reclamation Project.

NRC noted that responses to the request for additional information (RAIs) should be provided within 30 days from the date of September 14, 2021. Due to the technical nature and number of RAIs received, HMC is requesting a 90-day extension for submittal of RAI responses (December 13, 2021) in order evaluate the RAIs.
