2. Estimated quantity is 0.01 Curie.
3. Site is located at Armed Forces Experimental Training Activity (AFETA), Camp Peary, Williamsburg, Virginia.
4. The overall radiation safety scope of the project is to perform radiological screening of excavated soil and debris at AFETA Camp Peary. Radioactive material generated is secured and stored on the AFETA property until transferred to Navy contract waste broker for off-site disposition.
5. Project period of performance is from September 30, 2021 to Sept 30, 2022.
