Dear Mr. Dean:

This letter refers to your license renewal application dated August 31, 2021, Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession no. ML21244A339. In reviewing your application, we have determined additional information is required to complete our review. In order to continue our review, please address the issues listed below. This information is required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 32.14, "Manufacture, distribution and transfer of exempt quantities of byproduct material: Requirements for license."

1. Please provide copies of your current possession licenses issued by the State of Pennsylvania and the State of Tennessee.
2. The current name of your U.S. Regulatory Commission (NRC) license is "Philips Lighting Company, A Division of Philips Electronics North America Corporation," which is different from your application Item No. 2, "Signify North America." Please clarify this is name change only.
3. Describe chemical and physical form and maximum quantity of byproduct material in each product. Please provide a list of the products with model numbers that shows which model containing Krypton-85 and/or Hydrogen-3.
4. Some similar products on the market containing thorium, please clarify that your products do not contain any thorium.
5. The method of containment or binding of the byproduct material in the product.
6. Provide details of construction and design of each product.
7. Provide the method of labeling or marking each unit, and its container with the identification of the manufacturer or initial transferor of the product and the byproduct material in the product.
8. The radiation level and the method of measurement.

9. Confirm that your current distribution locations at 7265 Route 54, Bath, New York; and 1375 East Locust St., Ontario, California will be removed from your license.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390 (b)(1).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's ADAMS.
