PART I.D -- COMMENTS

This is the first interim response to your FOIA request, submitted to the NRC on 3/4/2021.

We tasked your request to NRC's Office of the Secretary (SECY). SECY staff viewed the web site you provided, https://www.governmentattic.org/8docs/NRCstaffDocsSECYdbNonPublic_1975-1989.pdf. They noticed that the last two pages have the dates out of order, showing 1989 instead of 2011, and how your report is thru May 2011.
