Dear Ms. Thompson:

We have reviewed your license renewal application for NRC License No. 21-24652-01 for VHS Huron Valley-Sinai Hospital, Inc. in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) and the NRC licensing guidance related to your license (NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses" which can be found on the NRC's website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v9/index.html>.) Please note that NRC policy is to renew a materials license in its entirety.

Based on the review, it appears that your application did not prepare in accordance with NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3. You filled out only NRC Form 313 and attached a copy of your license (Amendment No. 38 dated July 30, 2018). We will need additional information to renew your license. Please provide the following.

1. A copy of the delegation of authority for the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and the RSO contact information (work phone, work email, etc.) A sample of the delegation of authority for the RSO from NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3 is attached for your reference.
2. Based on your license amendment No. 38, please provide information as marked and highlighted in the attached Appendix C to NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3. As always, you can provide an alternative response for each section as described in the guidance.

3. Confirming if PET isotopes will be used or not. If you will use PET isotopes, please provide shielding calculations and facility shielding for areas where PET isotopes will be used (see Item 9, "Facility Diagram" in the attached Appendix C).

To continue the review of your application, we request that you submit your response under a dated and signed cover letter by October 25, 2021. In the cover letter, please reference the license number (21-24652-01), docket number (030-29063) and Mail Control No. 625671. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.

If you have questions, require additional time to respond, or require clarification on any of the information stated above, please contact me at 630-829-9623 or reply to this email.
