Dear Administrative Judges,

In its Partial Initial Decision (LBP-16-7) issued May 26, 2016, the Board directed the NRC Staff to submit monthly status reports updating the Board and parties as to the status of the Staff's curative actions in response to the Board's resolution of Contention 1.

During the October 12, 2021 status conference, counsel reported that the parties were nearing completion of the remaining steps needed to start the cultural resources survey of the Crow Butte Resources, Inc. (CBR) license area. These steps included various reviews and approvals within the Oglala Sioux Tribe, execution of the contract by the Tribe and Quality Services, Inc., establishment of a bank account by the Tribe to receive the funds, and transfer of the funds by CBR.

Over the next several weeks, with the assistance of the Tribe's in-house counsel, Mr. Russel Zephier, the necessary Tribal reviews were completed, and the Staff received confirmation on October 28 that both parties had executed the contract. In addition, during that time period the Staff project managers and their contractor held several logistics meetings with CBR personnel, Mr. Rom of Quality Services, Inc., and Messrs. Salway and Brings of the Tribe.

Ms. Diaz-Toro (one of the Staff's project managers) and Mr. Spangler (the Staff's contractor) are in Nebraska and the onsite field work is scheduled to begin this afternoon (November 1) at 2 p.m. local time (MDT).
