FL regulation equivalents are 64E-5.626 = 35.100; 64E-5.627 = 35.200; 64E-5.630 (1) = all 35.300; 630(2) = 35.300 I-131 less than or equal to 33mCi; 630(3) = 35.300 I-131 greater than 33mCi; and 630(4) = 35.300 parenteral use.

For Dr. Watal authorization is for 100, 200, and all 300
For Dr. Naffaa authorization is for 100 and 200 uses only.

Lena A. Naffaa, M.D. – looks like maybe 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200, but they are limited to only 1 category?

Anyway, if you could help me, I would greatly appreciate it. If it is easier for me to directly contact someone from the State of Florida, I am good with that too.
