SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2020-017)

Dear Mr. Reasoner:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Office of Investigations regarding activities at Wolf Creek Generating Station (Wolf Creek). The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine if non-licensed operators (NLOs) Wolf Creek willfully left valve EJ-V244 in an open position instead of the required closed position and disregarded required independent verification checks. The investigation also sought to determine whether Wolf Creek failed to maintain accurate information when documenting valve manipulations and verifications with completing the SYS EJ-110A (Train A Residual Heat Removal (RHR) Fill and Vent) procedure.

Based on the evidence developed during this investigation, the allegation that NLOs at Wolf Creek willfully left valve EJ-V244 in an open position, instead of the required closed position, and disregarded independent verification checks was not substantiated.

The NRC also did not substantiate deliberate misconduct associated with the failure to maintain accurate information when documenting valve manipulations and verifications with completing procedure SYS EJ-110A. On August 9, 2021, the NRC issued inspection report 05000482/2021002 that included a non-willful Severity Level IV non-cited violation of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 50.9, "Completeness and Accuracy of Information," associated with this issue. The NRC plans no further action related to the wrongdoing aspects of the case and considers this investigation closed.
