I hope this email finds you well. My name is Ashley Roberts and I am the deputy director for the Division of Decommissioning, Uranium Recovery, and Waste Programs (DUWP) at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. In a letter to you dated October 6, 2021 from Robert Lewis, deputy director of the NRC's Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (ML21265A195), the NRC provided information on the status of the review for the Western Nuclear Incorporated (WNI) Split Rock former uranium mill in Jeffery City, WY. As indicated in that letter, the NRC planned to update the remaining schedule of milestones in November 2021. I have attached an updated schedule of these milestones towards termination of the WNI Split Rock license and transfer to the Department of Energy (DOE) for long-term care.
