16. Scope and Observations:

This was an announced, routine inspection of a clinic authorized by its NRC license to use unsealed byproduct material for diagnostic procedures under 10 CFR 35.200. At the time of the inspection, the licensee performed only cardiac studies, using unit doses of Tc-99m from a local radiopharmacy. The nuclear medicine department was staffed with one full-time nuclear medicine technologist (NMT) and performed approximately 20 procedures per week. The licensee has one hot lab at the clinic that operates from Mondays to Fridays. The licensee retains a consultant health physicist to perform annual audits of the radiation safety program and calibrations.

PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS

The inspector conducted a tour of the nuclear medicine hot lab and discussed with a NMT package receipt, surveys, and instrument quality control checks. The inspector observed the preparation and administration of one heart rest test. The NMT demonstrated adequate knowledge of radiation safety principles and practices through interviews. The inspector reviewed audit reports, instrument quality control, area survey, inventory, dose calibrator linearity and accuracy, leak tests, waste disposal records, and training. The inspector also reviewed monthly dosimetry reports which indicated annual whole-body and extremity doses were below regulatory limits.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
