This letter is to notify NRC that the Anheuser-Busch, LLC. St. Louis Brewery and Corporate Complex, General License Number GL-700118, located at One Busch Place, St. Louis, MO 63118, performed the following:

On Friday December 3, 2021 one radiation source (Electron Capture Detector) from a gas chromatograph at Anheuser-Busch, LLC, One Busch Place, St. Louis, MO 63118 was removed by a representative of and transferred to R M Wester and Associates Inc, 215 Indacom Drive, St. Peters, MO 63376 for subsequent disposal. R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. Radioactive Material License Number is 24-20091-01. The R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. contact person in charge of this source is their R.S.O. Mr. Joseph Koch.

The source, serial number 2519, contains 15 mCi of Ni-63. The gas chromatograph (model description and serial number listed below), containing no radioactive source, will be scrapped.
