## General Comment

I am opposed to the 80-year license sought by NextEra at Point Beach nuclear plant. The extreme license extension puts Lake Michigan, and points downstream — drinking water supply for tens of millions — at increasing risk, as from Unit 2's single worst embrittled reactor pressure vessel in the U.S. Old nuclear power plants should be retired and decommissioned, not given decades longer of operation. Do not extend the license of NextEra at Point Beach nuclear plant.
