Subject: Concerning the New Application for NRC Materials License
Discussion: Mr. vonEhr reached out to Mr. Mohammed to clarify certain items pertaining to the new portable gauge license application. These included: (1) Mr. Mohammed clarified that he was the principle, owner, and sole employee of the applicant, and therefore qualified to sign on behalf of the applicant; (2) after discussion of the maximum possession limit requested, Mr. Mohammed clarified that he would like a higher possession limit of 3 (three) Troxler Model 3400 Series Portable Gauges, rather than the initially requested 1 (one); (3) to satisfy the “hands on” language from Section 8.7.2 of NUREG-1556, Vol 1, Rev 2, Mr. Mohammed provided his professional experience with gauges, which included at least 8-10 years of direct gauge use and oversight with Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI) in Virginia, as well as various roles and responsibilities in the U.S. Virgin Islands with both direct and indirect responsibilities associated with portable gauge use; (4) Mr. Mohammed clarified that the request for leak test analysis was mistakenly added in the application under Section 10.8 “Maintenance,” and that this request can be voided; (5) Mr. vonEhr and Mr. Mohammed discussed two further commitments that would be communicated in writing; (6) the remaining application fee (\$5,600; \$1,000 having already been provided) and methods of payment; and whether a Pre-Licensing Visit (PLV) was necessary; and (7) Mr. Mohammed stated that his company did not have any existing Agreement State or NRC license(s), nor meet any of the other criteria from the PLV Checklist.

ACTION: Mr. vonEhr to provide written follow-up for the payment options (No. 5 above) for the remaining application fee and technical application commitments, and will coordinate with the RI/DRSS/CIRDA BC regarding the need for a PLV (No. 7 above).
