
Dear Mr. Robuck:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has forwarded the enclosed Notice of Consideration of Approval of Indirect Transfer of Licenses and Opportunity to Request a Hearing to the Office of the *Federal Register* for publication. This notice relates to your application dated December 7, 2021 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML21344A114) which transmitted a request for the indirect transfer of control of the EnergySolutions, LLC (EnergySolutions) licenses for: Zion Nuclear Power Station (ZNPS), Units 1 and 2 and its on-site independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI); Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 2 (TMI-2); La Crosse Boiling Water Reactor (LACBWR) and its ISFSI; EnergySolutions Materials License 39-35044-01; and EnergySolutions Export Licenses XW010/04 and XW018/01. The *Federal Register* notice will be published on January 21, 2021.
