LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
- 2. Previous violation(s) closed.
- 3. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.

2 Non-cited violation(s) were discussed involving the following requirement(s):

10 CFR 32.52 requires quarterly reporting of devices distributed under 10 CFR 31.5. The licensee had records for each quarter but they were not all entered into ADAMS. The licensee indicated that future reports would be sent certified mail to confirm receipt.

10 CFR 32.53 requires annual reporting of luminous safety devices installed in aircraft. The licensee did not include a negative declaration of distribution in their quarterly reports above. The licensee stated that distribution reports for luminous safety devices would be submitted on an annual basis prior to January 31st of each year.

- 4. During this inspection, certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. This form is a NOTICE OF VIOLATION, which may be subject to posting in accordance with 10 CFR 19.11. (Violations and Corrective Actions)
