

(Violations and Corrective Actions)

Contrary to 10 CFR 40.42(d)(3) as of April 13, 2019, no principal activities under Material License No. 21-35145-01 had been conducted for a period of 24 months, and Niowave Inc. did not notify the NRC in writing within 60 days of this occurrence.

As corrective action for this Severity Level IV violation, the licensee reviewed the relevant requirements and submitted notification of no principal activities on December 28, 2021 concurrent with a request to transfer authorization for material possessed under this license to license no. 21-35145-02 and to thereafter terminate this license.
