Dear Mr. Bolen:

We have reviewed your license amendment request for NRC License No. 13-32402-01. We reviewed your application in accordance with the NRC regulations and licensing guidance, NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Revision 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Academic, Research and Development, and Other Licenses of Limited Scope" which can be found on the NRC's website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v7/index.html>. Based on the review, we will need the following information.

1. A copy of the delegation of authority for Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) to confirm that the proposed RSO is aware of the RSO's duties and responsibility and has accepted the RSO position. (A sample of the memo is in Appendix E of NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Revision 1. A copy is attached for your reference.)
2. Based on NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Revision 1, the proposed user should have (i) a college degree at the bachelor's level or equivalent training and experience in physical, chemical, biological sciences, or engineering; and (ii) training and experience commensurate with the scope of proposed activities. Please provide information about the education and experience related to licensed activities with licensed material (including the duration of the experience) for the proposed user, Mr. Michael Linn.
3. Appendix M to NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Revision 1, provides recommendations for contamination survey frequency. You request to change the contamination survey from weekly to monthly. Please provide a confirmation that radioactive material which will be used at any one time at any particular location will be less than 0.1 of the annual limit for intake (ALI) as listed in 10 CFR part 20, Appendix B.

To continue the review of your application, we request that you submit your response under a dated and signed cover letter (signed by the licensee senior executive management or designee) by January 18, 2022. In the cover letter, please reference Mail Control No. 629280.
