SUBJECT: TIMKIN MOTOR & CRANE SERVICES, LLC, REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, MAIL CONTROL NO. 629074

Dear Mr. Rapp:

This is in reference to your letter dated October 25, 2021 and your email dated January 13, 2022, requesting to add a second financial assurance instrument for the new location on NRC License No. 06-31045-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

We have accepted the cost estimate based on the Decommissioning Funding Plan dated August 2021 for the 110 Commerce Street location, and the Surety Bond that was provided. As discussed in the email dated January 13, 2022, a Surety Bond usually requires you to establish a Standby Trust Account to receive the money from the Surety Bond at the time of decommissioning. However, you currently have an active Trust Agreement that provides the financial assurance for the 30 Gando Drive location and requested if that could be used instead of establishing a Standby Trust Account.

Based on information provided by our program office advisor for financial assurance, you may use the existing Trust Fund to receive funds from the Surety, as follows:

- a. You will need to revise the Schedule A to your Trust Agreement to include the additional address of licensed activities.
- b. It appears that you should revise the Schedule A with the additional cost estimate for the new address. It would be acceptable to list each address with its cost estimate separately.
- c. It appears that you should revise Schedule B to reflect the additional amount of the Surety Bond.

Please submit revised Schedule(s) to your Trust Agreement.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. In this case, because the Schedules do not require a signature, the document may be provided by electronic mail sent directly to me at Elizabeth.Ullrich@nrc.gov, referencing Mail Control No. 629074.
