SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF REVIEW OF AMENDMENT REQUEST DATED APRIL 28, 2021 FOR RADIOCAT, LLC, NRC LICENSE NO. 45-25330-01, MAIL CONTROL NO. 625737

Dear Dr. Wachsstock:

We have reviewed your request to amend your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License No. 45-25330-01. You have requested to modify your release requirements for cats treated with Iodine-131. Specifically, you have requested to release the cats 48 hours post treatment, and when the exposure rate at 1 meter is less than or equal to 0.5 mR/hr. Your amendment request is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML21134A028.

Based on the review, our office determined that additional information was needed from you to further evaluate your amendment request. Accordingly, we prepared and sent you a written request for additional information via electronic mail dated October 18, 2021 (ML21291A203). As discussed subsequently via several telephone conversations between our staff and Mr. Eli Port, the amendment request is lacking significant amounts of information. To date, that information has not been provided to our office. In Mr. Port's letter dated November 16, 2021 (ML21321A294), he indicated that you needed additional time to gather, prepare, and submit the requested information. Accordingly, as discussed, we have suspended review of your amendment request pending receipt of the additional requested information. Due to the delay in receiving the additional requested information that is necessary for review of your application, the NRC cannot project when it will make a determination on the amendment request. Once a complete response is received, the NRC will provide an updated date for the NRC to complete its review. If an adequate response is not received by January 31, 2022, the NRC may decide to administratively close or deny the request. If we do close the request, you may submit a new request and can refer to Mail Control No. 625737 for the documentation you have already submitted.
