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Good afternoon Ms. Kritzman;

I have reviewed the licensee's request to name you as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) on NRC license no. 13-32723-01 for Cameron Memorial Community Hospital.

Because you are named the RSO and are overseeing multiple facilities where radioactive material is used, please provide additional information as listed below in accordance with the guidance in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 3:

1. Confirm that the proposed RSO will allocate adequate time at the facility to permit the performance of the duties of the RSO as described in the regulations.
2. Identify an in-house representative who will serve as the point of contact during the RSO's absence.
3. Describe the overall availability of the consultant-RSO to respond to questions or operational issues that arise during the conduct of the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements.
4. Specify the maximum amount of time it will take the consultant-RSO to arrive at the facility in the event of an emergency that requires his presence.

Please sign the letter and have senior management (Andy Aldred) cosign the letter as well. I need to understand that Cameron Memorial Community Hospital management is aware that you are a consultant RSO.
