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LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:


10 CFR 32.25(c) requires, in part, that the licensee shall file a report with the Director of the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards, including in the address: ATTN: Document Control Desk / Exempt Distribution. The licensee shall file the report, covering the preceding calendar year, on or before January 31 of each year.

Contrary to the above, from February 1, 2018 through October 18, 2021, the licensee failed to file a report with the Director of the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards, including in the address: ATTN: Document Control Desk / Exempt Distribution. The licensee failed to file the report, covering the preceding calendar year, on or before January 31 of each year. Specifically, the licensee failed to file its annual distribution report for Calendar Year 2017, due by January 31, 2018, and each calendar year thereafter through the date of the inspection.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (NRC Enforcement Policy 6.9.d). To correct this violation, the licensee prepared and submitted distribution reports for Calendar Year 2017 through 2020, and committed to creating reminder systems (with redundancy) to ensure timely reports in the future.

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved). I understand that no further written response to NRC will be required, unless specifically requested.
