NOTICES, INSTRUCTIONS AND REPORTS TO WORKERS; INSPECTIONS

Background and History.

Part J of the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors (CRCPD), Suggested State Regulations (SSR) was developed to incorporate the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) 10 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 19.

Part J was last revised in 2003. Since then, there has been an amendment made to 10 CFR 19. This revision to Part J incorporates the changes to 10 CFR 19 and is intended to make Part J compatible with 10 CFR 19.

Specific Provisions.

- J.13.b Revised J.13.b so that licensees must provide an annual report to each individual monitored of the dose received in that monitoring year if (1) the individual's occupational dose exceeds 1 millisievert (mSv) (100 millirem (mrem)) TEDE or 1 mSv (100 mrem) to any individual organ or tissue; or (2) the individual requests his or her annual dose report. (RATS 2008-1)
