Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of August 8, 1961, in reply to our letter of July 26, 1961.

It appears that the corrective steps you propose are adequate with respect to Items 1, 4, 5 and 6 of our letter. However, you do not state what measures you will take to correct the deficiencies described in Item 2 of our letter.

You will note that pursuant to 10 CFR 20, Section 20.105, paragraph (b), radiation levels in the areas described in Item 2 of our letter may not exceed the levels specified in that paragraph unless the Commission authorizes such levels pursuant to paragraph (a) of the same section. The posting of these radiation areas may not in itself be sufficient to restrict entry of unauthorized persons. Unless the areas are adequately restricted by fence or enclosure, you must reduce the levels of radiation to within those levels specified in Section 20.105, paragraph (b), or obtain an amendment to your license pursuant to Section 20.105, paragraph (a) to authorize higher levels.

You have stated in Item 1 of your letter that you, "will immediately post signs in the areas listed under 2(a), (b) and (c) of your letter, showing these areas in fact to be 'Radioactive Area'." Please note that Section 20.203(b) requires that such areas be posted with a sign bearing "The Radiation Caution Symbol" and the words, "Caution (Danger) - Radiation Area."

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201(a), "Notice of violation," of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, you are requested to notify this office, within fifteen (15) days of your receipt of this notice, of the steps taken or to be instituted to correct these deficiencies, and the date when such correction has been or will be achieved.

If your company decides to dispose of the licensed materials in your possession, we suggest the following authorized channels through which you may sell or dispose of them:

1. Any AEC licensee authorized to possess and process such materials.
2. Land burial disposal service described in enclosure No. C-85.
3. Disposal through a commercial firm holding an AEC license to receive and dispose of radioactive wastes. See enclosure entitled, "Commercial Firms Holding AEC License to Receive and Dispose of Radioactive Waste."
