**SUBJECT: Notice of Closing of Indirect Transfer of Control

Dear Mr. Parker and Ms. Frazier:

Per consent letters dated November 4, 2021, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) approved the transfer of control of the below listed NRC Materials Licenses (the “Licenses”), held by wholly-owned subsidiaries of Beaumont Health (the “Licensees”). Approval of the indirect transfer of control was pursuant to a change of control application dated September 16, 2021 and submitted by Beaumont and Spectrum Health System (the “Applicants”). Spectrum Health and Beaumont Health to Launch New Health System on Feb. 1
Board members and leadership team named for new organization

The new system, which will be temporarily known as BSH System, will launch Feb. 1, 2022. Both organizations have provided the applicable regulatory agencies with all requested information and may now proceed to launch their new health system.
