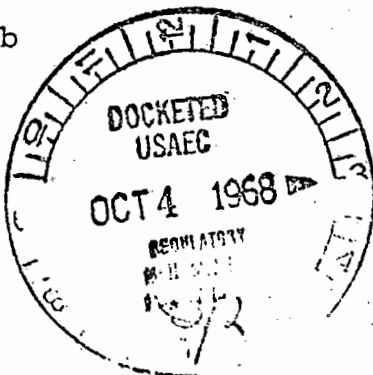
This will include the letter of August 9, 1968, from Isotopes to STEPAN, my letter of August 15 to the AEC, and the AEC reply dated September 6, 1968.

This refers to your letter dated August 15, 1968, concerning the unrestricted release of two areas of your property identified as "Former waste storage area - Building #77" and "South Dike - storage area".

Based on the data provided in your letter and data obtained by our Division of Compliance during an inspection of the subject areas on September 5, 1968, we have concluded that due to the insignificance of the contamination which may be present in this particular instance, no hazard to health and safety is involved as a result of AEC licensed activities. Accordingly, the subject areas may be released on an unrestricted basis.

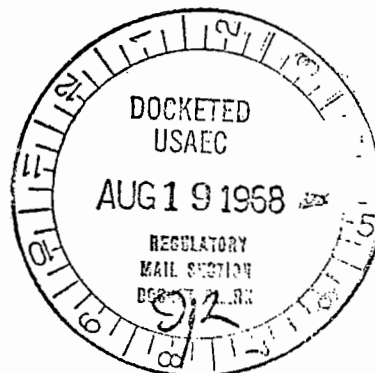
