We have received your letter dated January 27, 2022, transmitting the annual update to the Integrated Safety Analysis Summary. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff completed a preliminary review of the information provided and identified no major deficiencies. In accordance with the Staff Requirements Memorandum for SECY-16-0009, "Recommendations Resulting from the Integrated Prioritization and Re-Baselining of Agency Activities" (ML16104A158), the NRC licensing staff will no longer perform detailed reviews of such documents. Therefore, no cost activity code has been assigned to this action. Nevertheless, please note that a detailed review may be performed by the NRC inspection staff in the future.
