On January 19, 2022 and January 20, 2022, you submitted four FOIA requests to our office. These requests were assigned reference numbers NRC-2022-000064, NRC-2022-000065, NRC-2022-000068, and, NRC-2022-000069. In your requests you sought sightings of any "Unidentified Flying Object"/ "UFO"/ "Unidentified Aerial Phenomenon"/ "UAP" occurring at or near the vicinity of Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station, Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Limerick Generating Station, and Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, respectively.

Since the nuclear power plants are all located within Region I, along with the Office of Nuclear Security & Response (NSIR), we tasked these offices for a fee estimate. After sending you that fee estimate, and receiving your advance payment, we tasked RI and NSIR to search for any responsive records. In their effort to fashion an appropriate search, RI staff sought clarification of the search terms that should be used. On February 14th, we spoke with you about the search terms we should use. You stated that, for each location (and for the time periods identified), the following terms should be used: (1) "Unidentified Flying Object," (2) "UFO," (3) "Unidentified Aerial Phenomena," and (4) "UAP." In view of the search terms you specified, the number of hours estimated to be needed to conduct a search for responsive records was too high; as such, you will receive a refund of the advanced payment you made.

No responsive records were located.
