I. SECY-78-13 and SECY-78-13A - Recommendations on Course of Action
for Establishing Nuclear Facility Decommissioning Requirements

The Commission discussed the merits of either initiating separate rulemaking actions for each class of nuclear facility or initiating a comprehensive overall rulemaking. The Commission, by a vote of 4-0, approved the initiation of a generic rulemaking action as recommended in SECY-78-13, approved the publication of the proposed notice of the initiation of this policy in the Federal Register, and approved the schedule for disposition of the PIRG petition. (SD)

II. SECY-78-63 - Dollar Per Man-Rem Rulemaking

The Commission, by a vote of 4-0, directed the staff to prepare and circulate to the Commissioners for concurrence, an Order suspending the Dollar Per Man-Rem Rulemaking. The Commission directed that this Order point out the factors involved in this decision, and that this Order will in no way eliminate Appendix I. (SD) (SECY Suspend: March 1, 1978)

III. SECY-78-33 - Compliance with Section 1(d) of NRC Authorization Act
for FY '78 -- Advanced Reactor Safety Research Contracts

The Commission, by a vote of 4-0, approved the proposed memorandum for the Secretary's signature. (OGC)

Commissioner Gilinsky requested a summary of the staff's reactions to the recommendations of NUREG-0392. This request was the subject of a previous memorandum (1/16/73, Chilk to Gossick, subject: NUREG-0392). (RES) (SECY Suspend: March 1, 1978)
