The revision log of the SQN Physical Security Plan, Training and Qualification Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation Security Program provided in the enclosure describes each change. The revised plan became effective as of January 19, 2022.

Tennessee Valley Authority has evaluated the changes contained in this revision and does not consider the revision to decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the subject plan. The documented evaluation is available on-site for inspection.


