SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 26-27699-01

By letter dated February 22, 2022, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that Niobrara Valley Consultants LLC, wished to terminate NRC radioactive materials license number 26-27699-01. Your letter stated that all radioactive material had been returned to a licensed device manufacturer for disposal.

In support to the license termination request you provided a copy of the most recent leak test result showing that there was no evidence of leakage of radioactive material from the sealed sources contained in the device. NRC license number 26-27699-01 authorizes work only at temporary job sites in NRC jurisdiction. Based on the statements made and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all NRC licensable radioactive material was adequately disposed, and that there are no storage locations in NRC jurisdiction that need to be released for unrestricted use.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 3 to license number 26-27699-01 authorizing license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
