This refers docket # 03037381 and invoice LFB 22-1193. We are requesting a change in name and amendment to the license. The source is currently listed under Kentucky Power an American Electric Power Company that is being sold. We are requesting a change in name to Wheeling Power an American Electric Power Company.

- When Mitchell plant's ownership changes from Kentucky Power to Wheeling Power the Plant Manager, Douglas J Rosenberger will not change, our corporate structure will not change, our plant processes will not change, sources will not move and the RSO's will stay the same.
- 2. It's only a name change taking place.
- 3. There have not been any changes in the physical locations where our licensed material is used, changes in equipment, or in procedures involving the source.
- 4. Our surveillance program is current. All required six-month leak tests are current; all annual fees are current and documented.
- 5. Mitchell plant has multiple RSO's with training and experience. They will stay the same before and after the change in name.
- 6. Per NUREG 1556 Vol 15, Rev1 section 5.6, I Douglas J Rosenberger, the Plant Manager before and after the name change, agree that the licenses will abide by all constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations and commitments identified in and attributed to the existing license. There are no existing licensing actions to resolve with respect to open inspections and enforcement issues.
