Subject: UWNR TS typographical edits

Mr. Agasie,

As discussed on our conference call earlier today, we identified some typographical items in some of the Technical Specification (TS) pages submitted as part your July 1, 2020, license amendment request (LAR) (ADAMS Accession no. ML02192A111). The typographical items are listed below and the NRC suggested additional text or punctuation is noted in **Bold** font.

- Page TS-55
 - TS 6.2.1
 - In the first line of section 6.2.1, it appears that the word “a” should be “at”. The revision would state “...shall be composed of **at** least...”
 - TS 6.2.1, specification 3., appears to be missing a semicolon.
 - Add a semicolon following “Metallurgy;”
 - TS 6.2.1, specification 5., appears to be missing the word “and”
 - Add “and” after the semicolon following “...Radio-chemistry; **and**...”
- Page TS-56
 - TS 6.2.3, specification 4.
 - Remove the word “and” after the semicolon

- TS 6.2.3, specification 5.
 - Replace the period at the end of the statement with a semicolon “;”
- TS 6.2.3, specification 6.
 - Replace the period at the end of the statement with a semicolon “;”
 - Add the word “and” after the added semicolon following “... reports; **and**”
- Page TS-62
 - TS 6.7.2, specifications 1.a. and 1.b.
 - Replace the semicolons with periods “.” at the end of the statement
 - TS 6.7.2, specification 2.b.
 - Replace the semicolon with a period “.” at the end of the statement

The NRC staff is prepared to implement these changes, as noted above, with the issuance of the LAR, if you provide confirmation in your response to this electronic message (email) that you want the NRC staff to make these changes, and that the changes only correct typographical items, and do not change the meaning or the interpretation of the TSs. Also, as previously discussed, this email, including your response, will be described in the Safety Evaluation Report issued with the LAR, and a copy (email) will be made publicly available in ADAMS.
