SUBJECT: CANADIAN COLLEGE OF PHYSICISTS IN MEDICINE, RESPONSE TO REVIEW OF SPECIALTY BOARD CONTINUED RECOGNITION BY THE US NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION

Dear Kevin Williams,

I am writing to confirm that the Canadian College of Physicists in Medicine (CCPM) continues to satisfy the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) recognition criteria for specialty board certification purposes.

Per the US NRC letter dated March 15, 2022, CCPM confirms:

1. Its current name is the Canadian College of Physicists in Medicine (CCPM).
2. Specialty certification or certificates have not changed and continue to be offered in four distinct sub-specialties: Diagnostic Radiological Physics; Magnetic Resonance Imaging; Nuclear Medicine Physics; and Radiation Oncology Physics.
3. The CCPM continues to satisfy the board recognition criteria in 10 CFR 35.51, "Training for an authorized medical physicist."
4. There have been no changes in the board's certification procedures that could affect the recognition status.
