Mr. Weismann,

I am writing to follow-up on your letter, dated April 23, requesting NRC concurrence on 20.2008 and 40.13(a) exemptions for certain material from a facility owned by the City of Chicago in Illinois. In discussions with my management and our Office of General Counsel, it was determined that NRC staff would need to evaluate the impacts from disposal for 40.13(a) material. NRC staff had begun reaching out to the State of Illinois to ascertain additional information on the source term provided by the City of Chicago and recently learned that the City of Chicago is withdrawing its request to the State of Illinois for alternate disposal of the cleanup wastes. In light of this recent information, I am writing to inquire whether US Ecology would like NRC staff to continue evaluating your concurrence request or to cease work on the concurrence? Please confirm.
