Dear Mr. Salomon:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 16 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26151-01 in accordance with your request. By letter dated October 27, 2020, AK Steel Corporation - Dearborn Works, submitted to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to Indirect Change of Control of NRC Materials License No. 21-26151-01. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML20303A025.

Based on the information provided, we understand this transaction resulted from a merger between the parent company of Lafarge Midwest Inc., Lafarge S.A., and the parent company of Holcim US, Inc., Holcim. As a result of this merger, Lafarge Midwest Inc. became part of Holcim US, Inc. We further understand that this transfer did not result in any change to the licensed materials, locations of use, and the radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, the NRC consents to the indirect transfer of control.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 51.22(c).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary
