Good afternoon, James:

We have reviewed the amendment request and have two points of clarification, for which additional information is needed.

1. Regarding the change in the location of use address from Monroe Street to Michigan Street, could you please clarify which submitted facility diagram (if any) applies to that area of use. A facility diagram for the proposed areas of use is needed to complete the review. If a facility diagram has already been submitted, the clarification does not indicate the facility diagram submitted in a previous communication with the NRC.
2. Regarding the change in the possession limit for materials authorized under Title 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 35.300, please confirm that this limit is for radionuclides other than iodine-131, and that the Iodine-131 possession limit remains as 1 curie. Please note that, for possession limits exceeding those listed in the 10 CFR Section 30.72 Schedule C table, in accordance with 10 CFR 30.32(i), each application must contain either an emergency plan or an evaluation showing that an emergency plan is not needed.

Please provide your responses as a signed and dated letter, as a pdf file attached to an email. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call me or send an email.

Dear Mr. Botti:

We have reviewed the referenced November 29, 2021 license application. If you could respond to the following questions, to clarify information contained in the application, it is appreciated.

1. The application included your phone number and email address, but contained no phone number or email address for the licensed facility or direct staff member of the licensee. Please provide a licensee staff member name & title, together with phone number and email address, for the facility where materials will be used and stored.

2. The application indicated a possession limit of 1 curie of iodine-131 to be used under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 35.300. Our understanding is that the possession limit for 10 CFR 35.300 materials is 1 curie. If needed, please indicate if additional capacity is needed for 10 CFR 35.300 radionuclides other than iodine-131.
3. Under Item 8.10.10, "Material Receipt and Accountability," the application referenced policies associated with a temporary job site trailer. However, it is NRC's understanding that the facility is not a trailer but a single location of use. Please confirm that neither trailer use nor temporary jobsite use is anticipated, under the license.

Either a brief response via email, or a signed and dated letter as a pdf file attached to an email would be fine.
