Dear Director,

The purpose of this letter is to provide 14-day prior notification of conducting temporary work under license# 20-31340-01. Specific information as required by paragraph 18A of the license is provided.

1. The primary radionuclide of concern is Ra-226, solid form, from historical naval air station operations. Estimated quantity is 0.002 mCi.
2. Site is located at former Naval Air Station Willow Grove, Site 12 Landfill, Willow Grove, Pennsylvania.
3. The overall scope of the project is to perform radiological control support for potential Navy material removals at the Site 12 Landfill. Radioactive material generated is secured and stored on the air station property until transferred to Navy contract waste broker for off-site disposition.
4. Project is estimated to start April 18, 2022 and continue through July 29, 2022.
