

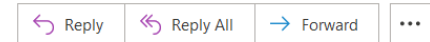

Hi Larry – I hope this email finds you well. I understand you spoke with Tom Lancaster yesterday about some questions he had as he was reviewing some of the information provided in your April 1, 2022 letter to John Lubinski. Tom shared that you will be providing some additional information by Tuesday of next week; thank you for that. We want to be transparent about schedule impacts, which I know Tom mentioned as well, so we will be updating our public schedule to reflect a slight shift to the right for the dates related to the LTCF, but this will not impact the final license termination and transfer date of 9/27/2022, as published in our March 31, 2022 schedule. I didn't want you to be surprised by the schedule update. Please let me know if you would like to discuss.
