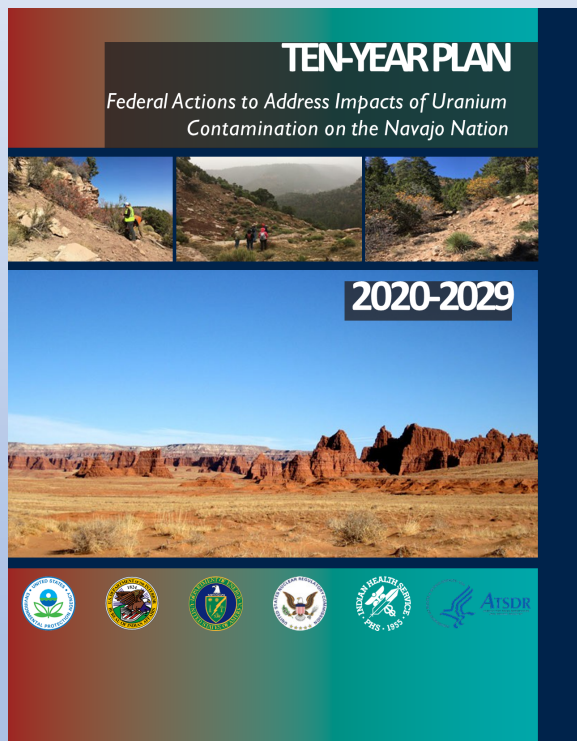

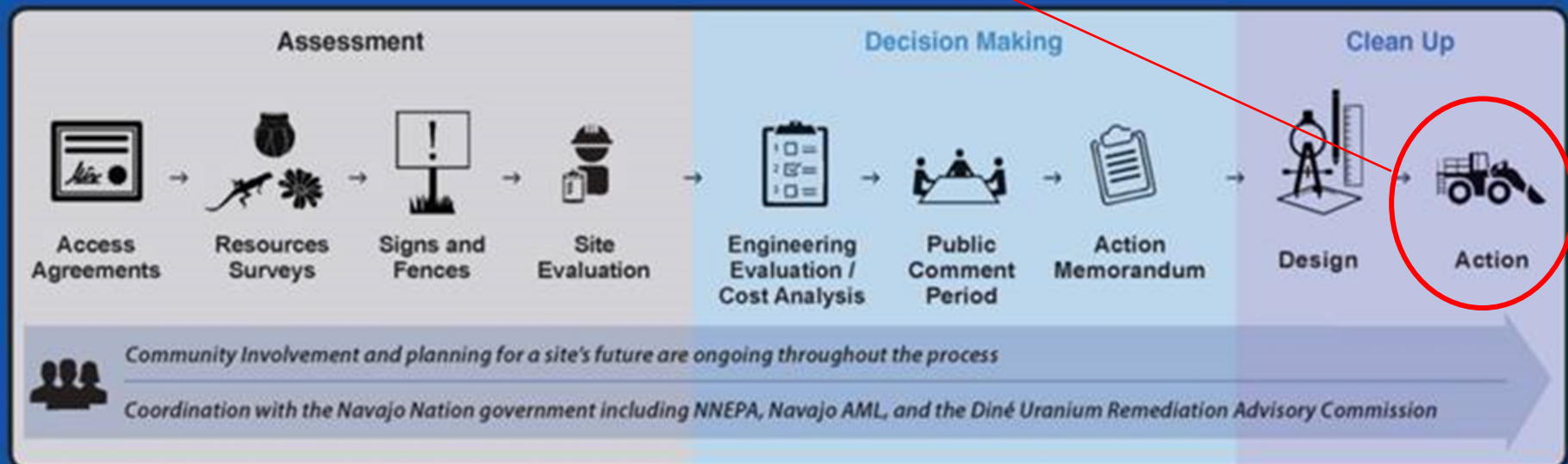




# Superfund CERCLA Process

## Superfund Process on the Navajo Nation

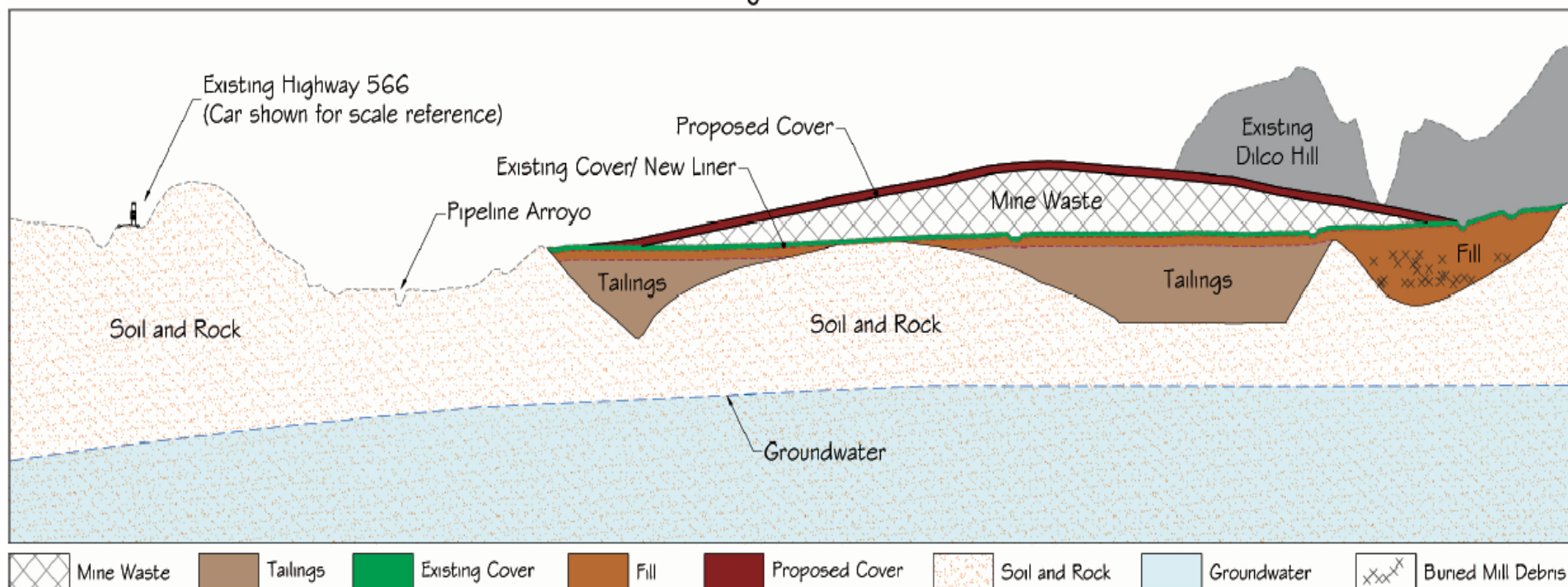

# Benefits to Mine Site & UNC Mill Site



- Restore ~125 acres of NN trust land
- Reduce contamination footprint
- Improve existing UNC Mill Site cover and stormwater controls
- Provide federal long-term stewardship
- Provide jobs in local area
- Remove distinct areas of highest concentration waste to licensed repository further away from Navajo Nation
