of the Southwest Quarter that lies South of the Union Pacific
Railroad track in Section 34 Township 1 South Range 4 East.

Dear Mr. Hodge:

The Planning and Zoning Commission grants to Envirosafe Services of Idaho, Inc., a permit that allows the construction of a transfer station to be built at the above-described location with the following use restrictions.

1. Gondola railcars transporting bulk hazardous waste will be off-loaded only within the transfer site building;
2. Waste in sealed containers maybe off-loaded outside the building provided proper precautions against spillage, as defined by State and Federal Law, are employed. Further, no containers of liquid hazardous waste shall be off-loaded outside the building and no containers of any hazardous waste shall be stored, as defined by State and Federal law, on the ground outside the building;
3. No hazardous waste shall be stored for more than ten (10) days on said property;
4. The Settlement Agreement between the County of Elmore and Envirosafe Services of Idaho, Inc., shall be complied with; and
5. Non-hazardous materials/waste may be off-loaded on the site.
