**Subject: Honeywell is Reporting Full Compliance with Security Order EA-02-025**

On March 25, 2002, the NRC issued an Order to Honeywell (Reference 2) that imposed certain security-related requirements in response to the then-current threat environment. The specific requirements imposed by the Order were described in Attachment 1 to the March 25 Order. Attachment 1 to the March 25 Order contains SAFEGUARDS information.

Because Honeywell had placed the Metopolis Works Plant (MTW) in a ready idle state, Honeywell submitted a letter (Reference 3) to the NRC on April 30, 2018 to request a temporary relaxation of specific requirements of the order. The NRC granted the Honeywell request for a temporary relaxation of the order on March 11, 2019 (Reference 4).


The following was a stipulation in the letter granting temporary relaxation of the order: "... As such, prior to the receipt of greater than 25 pounds of anhydrous hydrofluoric acid or the formation of liquid uranium hexafluoride, Honeywell must ensure that it is in full compliance with all the requirements of the Order, EA-02-025 dated March 25, 2002, and report to the Director, NMSS, when it has achieved full compliance with the requirements described in Attachment 1 of the Order"

This letter is to report that Honeywell is in full compliance with all of the requirements of the Security Order EA-02-025.
