LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
2. Previous violation(s) closed.

The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.

(Violations and Corrective Actions)


Condition 13.B of NRC License 17-35167-01, Amendment 2, dated August 31, 2020, states that the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this license is Luke Doiron.

Contrary to the above, as of the date of inspection on April 5, 2022, Luke Doiron was not the RSO for this license. Specifically, as of March 18, 2021, Kevin Hebert, a Field Supervisor for the licensee, had replaced Luke Doiron as the licensee's RSO. A letter documenting this change was sent to both the NRC and the State of Louisiana on March 18, 2021. The State of Louisiana received the letter and changed the RSO listed on the Louisiana license as requested, but the NRC never received the letter, and thus, did not change the RSO listed on the NRC license. The inspector identified this deficiency during the on-site inspection on April 5, 2022, and the licensee submitted the same letter electronically to the NRC on April 8, 2022 requesting the change of the RSO listed on the NRC license. On April 19, 2022, the NRC issued Amendment 3 to NRC License 17-35167-01 naming Kevin Hebert the licensee's RSO.

This is a Severity Level IV violation, in accordance with Example 6.3.d.8 of the NRC Enforcement Policy.

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the Inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved). I understand that no further written response to NRC will be required, unless specifically requested.
