Subject: Corporate Structure and Role within Current Corporate Structure

Discussion:

The NRC representatives held a conference call, via Teams, with Mike Sarrao to discuss the previous and current corporate structure of Alecto Healthcare Services. Mr. Sarrao elaborated on the ownership structure stating that Alecto Healthcare Services Wheeling, LLC was owned by Alecto Healthcare Services Ohio Valley, and both owned by the parent company, Alecto Healthcare Services. Mr. Sarrao also informed the NRC representatives that 20% of the Alecto Healthcare Services Wheeling, LLC location was owned by Medical Property Trust(MPT). MPT also owned the building and leased the building to Alecto. MPT released the building to the City of Wheeling approximately 3-4 months after the closure of the hospital and termination of the lease with Alecto. Michael Sarrao is the Executive Vice President of the company and has the authority to legally speak on behalf of the company. He also offered that Lex Reddy is the current CEO.

Mr. Klukan asked Mr. Sarrao if any records were still in possession of Alecto and if they have a radiation safety officer on staff. Mr. Sarrao stated that all records, which are mostly paper, have been retained by Alecto and that the company doesn't currently have an individual on staff, or contracted, to serve as the radiation safety officer. Mr. Sarrao stated that it would take approximately two weeks to locate any pertinent records to the disposal of licensed materials.

Mrs. DeFrancisco provided information regarding license status to Mr. Sarrao and requested establishment of a current address for Alecto in addition to confirming other contact information. Mr. Sarrao is to provide a signed letter to Patrick-John Hann establishing his legal authority to make decisions on behalf of Alecto, as well as a physical address for any correspondence to be sent to.

Mr. Sarrao again expressed a willingness to work with the City of Wheeling to resolve any issues pertaining to NRC licensed materials.

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
