8B. 8A. No single source to exceed the maximum activity specified in the certificate of registration issued by NRC or an Agreement State. Total Activity not to exceed 244 millicuries.

9. Authorized Use:

A and B In Portable Nuclear Density Gauges used for measuring physical properties of materials to include: Troxler Laboratories Inc. (3400 models) and Instrotek, Inc. (3500 models). Total number of these gauges not to exceed 6. Ownership of each model would not exceed the following: Three (3) Troxler Laboratories, Inc 3400 model gauges and three (3) Instrotek, Inc. 3500 model gauges.

All other conditions of the license will remain the same.
