Josh Borromeo is the current Branch Chief of the Non-Power Production and Utilization Facility Licensing Branch. Josh joined the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in 2015 as a Reactor Systems Engineer in the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR). At the NRC, Josh has worked on a number of complex projects including the NuScale Design Certification Application and Accident Tolerant Fuel (ATF).
