Dear Sir or Madam,

Cabrera Services Inc. (Cabrera) is providing written notification regarding completion of planned investigation of radiologically impacted drain lines at the Former National Urban Security Technology Laboratory (NUSTL) located at 201 Varick Street, New York, NY. Additional investigation activities and final radiological facility disposition are being addressed separately between NRC and stakeholder agencies and are outside the scope of this communication.

A final shipment of accumulated investigative wastes was prepared by Cabrera on behalf of the General Services Administration; eighteen 55-gal drums, one 110-gal drum, and seven B-25 boxes were transported by Veolia ES Technical Solution, LLC to a low-level radioactive materials processing facility in Wampum, PA (Alaron Nuclear) prior to final licensed disposition.

Radiological surveys were conducted prior to removal of temporary job site radiological controls with no elevated residuals identified above normal background in accessible areas. Cabrera owned/rented equipment and instrument performance check sources have been returned to their place of origin and the Authorized User has demobilized.
