Enclosed for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is the *Long-Term Surveillance Plan (LTSP) for the Slick Rock, Colorado, Disposal Site*.

The LTSP has been revised to remove the requirement for disposal cell water level monitoring and subsequent decommissioning of two standpipes. The site name of the LTSP has been updated to Slick Rock, Colorado, Disposal Site in keeping with U.S. Department of Energy's policy of using nearby town names. This revised document also reflects site asset updates or changes that reflect technological advances that improve the monitoring of the disposal cell.
